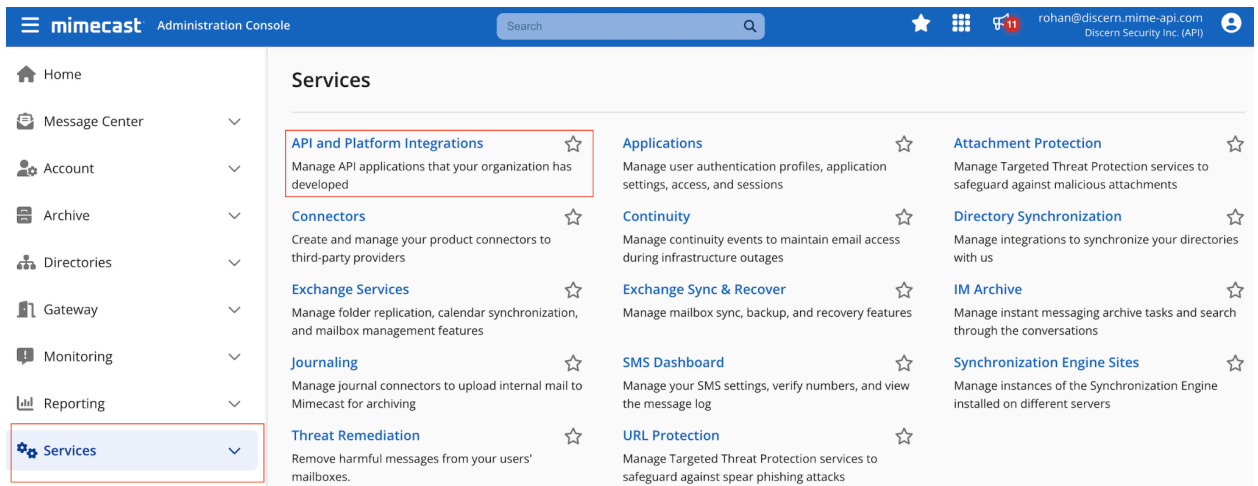

# Prerequisites

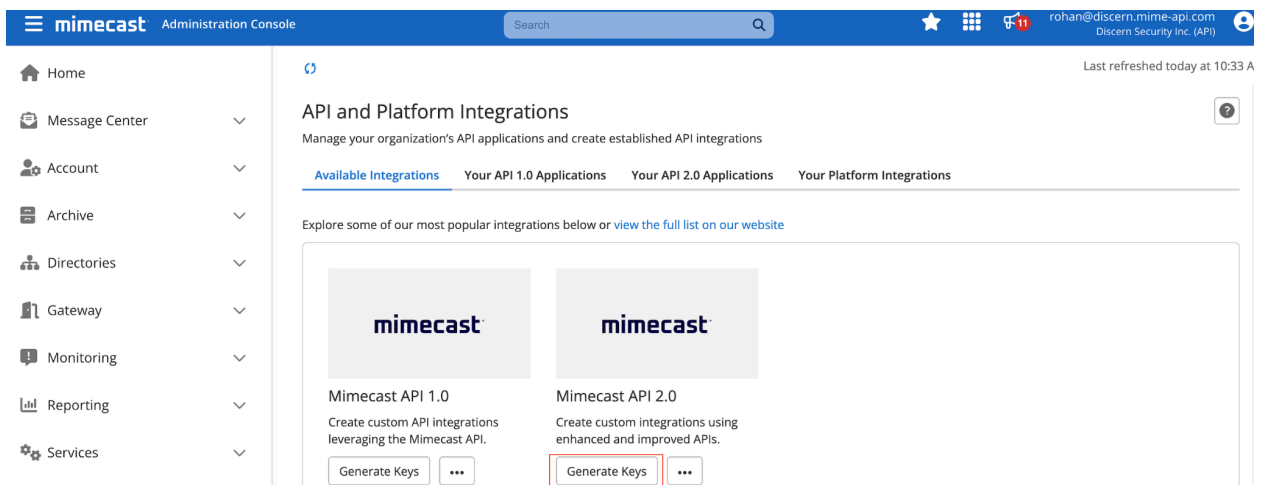
1. The user should have an admin role in the Mimecast console.

# Creating Credentials

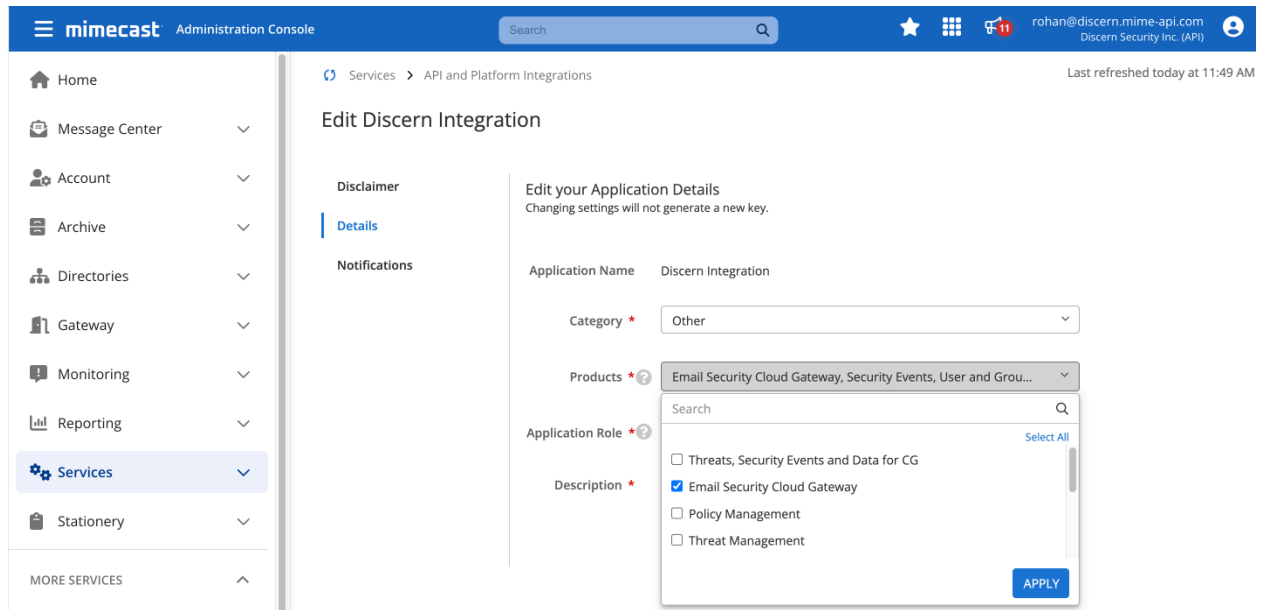
1. Log into the mimecast console.
2. From **Services** pick **API and Platform Integrations**.



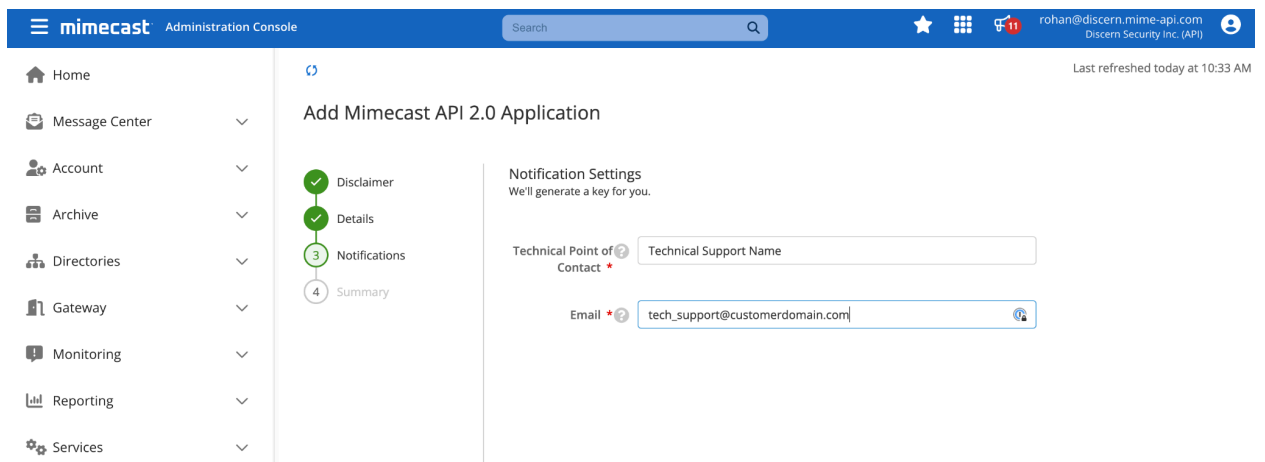
3. On the API and Platform Integrations page select **Mimecast API 2.0** and click **Generate Keys** button.



4. Go through the disclaimer. In Step 2 (**Details**) :
  - a. Enter Application Name
  - b. Select “**Other**” in the Category list.
  - c. Enable **Email Security Cloud Gateway, Domain Management, Security Events, User and Group Management**
  - d. Application Role as **Basic Administration**



5. Enter technical support details in the next step

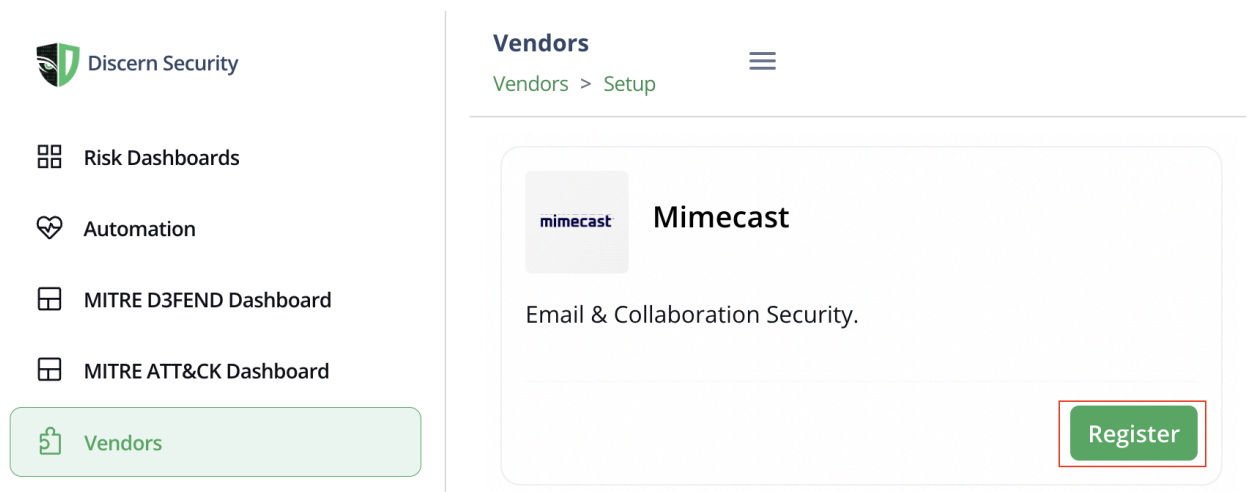

# Registering you application credentials in Discern

1. Log into the Discern web console. <https://ui.discernsecurity.com/authentication/signin>
2. Navigate to **Vendors** and then select **Register** in the Mimecast Vendor tab.



3. Enter the Client ID and the Client Secret generated in the previous step. Select all the Data Feeds listed. And click **Create Integration**
